കേരള സംസ്ഥാന ഭാഗ്യക്കുറിയുടെ സമ്മാന ഘടന അറിയിപ്പ് കഴിഞ്ഞിട്ടും, പരിഷ്കരിക്കുന്നതിനുള്ള അധികാരം പരാമർശ(1) ഉത്തരവ് പ്രകാരം സംസ്ഥാന ഭാഗ്യക്കുറി ഡയറക്ടറിൽ നിക്ഷിപ്തമാണ്. പ്രസ്തുത ഉത്തരവിന് വിധേയമായി സംസ്ഥാന ഭാഗ്യക്കുറിയുടെ -2011 -ലെ തിരുവോണം ബമ്പർ ഭാഗ്യക്കുറി-2011 (BR-21) ന്റെ സമ്മാന ഘടനയും നിബന്ധനകളും, വ്യവസ്ഥകളും പരാമർശം 2-ന് വിധേയമായി ഇതോടൊന്നിച്ച് 1 മുതൽ 3 വരെയുള്ള അനുബന്ധ പ്രകാരം അംഗീകരിച്ച് ഉത്തരവാകുന്നു.


തിരുവോണം ബമ്പർ -2011 (BR-21) ഭാഗ്യക്കുറിയുടെ ടിക്കറ്റിന്റെ മുഖവില 200/- രൂപയായിരിക്കും. 08.07.2011 ന് വിൽപ്പന ആരംഭിച്ച് 17.09.2011-ന് നറുക്കെടുപ്പ് നടത്തുന്ന പ്രസ്തുത ഭാഗ്യക്കുറിക്ക് അഞ്ച് പരമ്പരകളിലായി അകെ 35 ലക്ഷം ടിക്കറ്റുകൾ വിൽപ്പന പുരോഗതിക്കനുസരിച്ച് ഘട്ടംഘട്ടമായി അച്ചടിക്കുന്നതാണ്. ഒന്നാം സമ്മാനമായി 5 കോടി രൂപയും , രണ്ടാം സമ്മാനമായി 1 കോടി രൂപയും എല്ലാ പരമ്പരകൾക്കും പൊതുവായും, മൂന്നാം സമ്മാനമായി 50 പവൻ തങ്കം ഒന്ന് വീതവും, നാലാം സമ്മാനമായി 10 മാരുതി അൾട്ടോ (സ്റ്റാൻഡേർഡ്) കാർ രണ്ടെണ്ണം വീതവും ഓരോ പരമ്പരയിലും നൽകുന്നതാണ്.

ANNEXURE - III

THIRUVONAM BUMPER LOTTERY-2011 (BR.21) **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

1. Tickets will be printed in five series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be Rs.200/- only. One book of tickets will contain 5 tickets
3. The First to Fourth prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets. The third prize will be determined by drawing all the 6 digits one time and extended to all series. The IV prize will be determined by drawing all the 6 digits two times and extended to all series.
4. The Consolation prize of Rs.1,00,000/- each will be awarded to the tickets in other four series, having the same number of the 1st prize winning number.
5. The fifth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits two times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The sixth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits five times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The seventh prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits twenty times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. The eighth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits Twentyfive times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
9. The Ninth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits Fifty times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
10. If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn
11. An amount equal to 10% of the prize money will be deducted from 1st, 2nd and

consolation prizes and given as agents Commission on prize to the agents concerned. An amount of Rs.1,00,000 each on 3rd prize ie., 50 Sovereign and Rs.25000/- each on IV prize ie Maruti Alto (Standard Car) will be given to the agents concerned as agents commission on prize from Government Fund. An amount equivalent to 10% of the prize money on 5th to 7th and 15% of the prize money on 8th and 20% of the prize money on 9th prize will be given to the agents concerned as agents commission on prize from Government Fund.

12 (i) Admissible Income Tax as per Rule, Road Tax, Insurance for One Year and Registration Charge of Maruti Alto (Standard) Car will be met in full by the Government.

of (ii) The Gold Prize will be given as gold in 999.9 purity provided by State Bank India. Disbursement of Gold will be through the designated braches of State Bank of India in Kerala. Sales Tax , Income Tax and any other Taxes/Surcharge applicable on the Gold prize will be treated as part of the prize and met from Government Fund.

13 (i) Registered agents will get the tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the district of purchase.

- (a) Up to 10,000 tickets - 75% of the maximum retail price
- (b) 10,001 to 50000 tickets - 74% of the maximum retail price
- (c) 50,001 to 1,00,000 tickets - 73.5% of the maximum retail price
- (d) 1,00,001 to 3,00,000 tickets - 73.25.% of the maximum retail price
- (e) Above 3,00,000 tickets - 73% of the maximum retail price

(ii) The highest eligible discounted rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above-mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any, will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery, as the case may be, from the office of registration.

14 . Thiruvonam incentive for agents based on the sale of Thiruvonam Bumper Lottery tickets will be given at the following rates after the draw.

- a) Purchase upto 5000 tickets - Rs.100/- each for every 50 tickets.
- b) For purchase above 5000 tickets - Rs.10,000/- for the 1st 5000 tickets and Rs.10,000/ each for every block of 5000 tickets thereafter.

15 Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase maximum number of tickets as follows:-

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to the minimum of next lower purchaser.

16. Common incentive prize of **Rs.3,000/-** will be awarded to the agents registered in each district who purchase maximum number of tickets of and above **1,000** tickets. If more than one agent purchases same number of tickets in a district, the amount will be divided among them equally. The agents who become eligible for special incentive vide clause 15 will not be eligible for common incentive.
17. The prize- winners shall prefer their claims within 30 days from the date of draw. 1st to 4th prize winning tickets should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or by insured registered post or through Nationalised/ Scheduled Banks /State or District Co – operative Banks supported with necessary documents.
18. The prizes of **Rs.1,00,000/-** and below may be claimed from the District Lottery Offices/Directorate of State Lotteries. In the case of claimants from outside the state, the claims should be submitted in the Directorate. The prize-winners should record their name, address and signature in the space provided on the reverse side of the ticket. Payment of prize money will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time.
19. Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets with prize money of Rs.5,000/- and below and pay the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on behalf of the prize winners by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prize tickets are collected and prize money already paid to the prize winners by them, while presenting the same for payment.
20. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only the highest prize awarded on it. Income Tax and surcharge etc, if any, will be deducted at source from the prize money as laid down in the Finance Act. (Central).
21. Legal Jurisdiction of this Lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram.
